

Joy in Christ
The Peace of God
Philippians 4:1-9

1. If you want the peace of God, you must be like-minded.

*Philippians 4*¹ Stand firm in the Lord in this way, dear friends!

*Philippians 4*² I plead with Euodia and I plead with Syntyche to be of the same mind in the Lord.

2. If you want the peace of God, you need to trust Him with everything.

*Philippians 4*⁴ Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!

*Philippians 4*⁵ Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near.

*Philippians 4*⁶ Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.⁷ And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

*Matthew 6*²⁵ Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothes?

*Ephesians 6*¹⁸ And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests.

3. If you want the peace of God, you must focus on Godly things.

*Philippians 4*⁸ Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.

*Philippians 4*⁹ Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me—put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you.
