

**Built on Purpose**  
**How do we Worship?**  
**Matthew 22:37-38**

**Genesis 22** <sup>5</sup> “Stay here with the donkey,” Abraham told the servants. “The boy and I will travel a little farther. We will worship there, and then we will come right back.” (NLT)

**Matthew 22** You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind. <sup>38</sup> This is the first and greatest commandment. (NLT)

**1. We listen to God’s word and respond to it.**

**Deuteronomy 31** <sup>12</sup> Gather everyone—men, women, children, and the immigrants who live in your cities—in order that they hear it, learn it, and revere the Lord your God, carefully doing all the words of this Instruction. (CEB)

**James 1** <sup>22</sup> But don’t just listen to God’s word. You must do what it says. (NLT)

**2. We sing praises together to Him.**

**Psalms 89** <sup>1</sup> I will sing of the Lord’s great love forever; with my mouth I will make your faithfulness known through all generations. (NLT)

**Psalms 150** <sup>6</sup> Let everything that has breath praise the Lord. (NIV)

**3. We pray to Him together.**

**Matthew 18** <sup>19</sup> “I also tell you this: If two of you agree here on earth concerning anything you ask, my Father in heaven will do it for you. <sup>20</sup> For where two or three gather together as my followers, I am there among them.” (NLT)

**Acts 1** <sup>14</sup> The apostles often met together and prayed with a single purpose in mind. (CEV)

**4. We share the Lord’s Supper & get baptized publicly.**

**1 Corinthians 11** <sup>26</sup> For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until he comes. (ESV)

**Colossians 2** <sup>12</sup> When you were baptized, you were buried with Christ, and you were raised up with him through your faith in God’s power that was shown when he raised Christ from the dead. (NCV)

**Romans 6: 3-6** When we went under the water, we left the old country of sin behind; when we came up out of the water, we entered into the new country of grace—a new life in a new land! That’s what baptism into the life of Jesus means. When we are lowered into the water, it is like the burial of Jesus; when we are raised up out of the water, it is like the resurrection of Jesus. (MSG)

**5. We give back to Him what He has given us.**

**1 Corinthians 16** <sup>2</sup> *On the first day of every week each of you should put aside some of your money. Give a certain part of what you have earned. (NLV)*

**2 Corinthians 9** <sup>7</sup> *Everyone should give whatever they have decided in their heart. They shouldn't give with hesitation or because of pressure. God loves a cheerful giver. (CEB)*
